Communication and Language



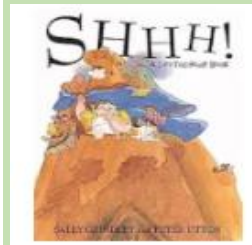
Re-telling the story using key vocabulary, singing songs, rhymes and learning poems linked to counting forwards and backwards.
