Communication and Language



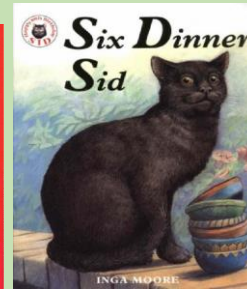
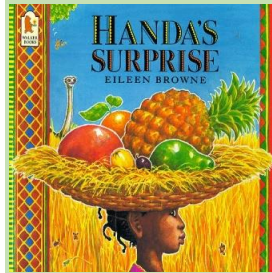
Re-telling and acting out the stories using key vocabulary, singing songs, rhymes and learning poems.
