# Child friendly Anti-bullying policy

What is bullying?

It means when you hurt someone over and over again on purpose. Not just once, lots of times.

If you are bullied...

**DO:**

Walk away.

Tell a grown up.

Shout stop.

If you are bullied...

**DON'T:**

Think it's your fault

Do it back

Hurt them

Hide it

**ALWAYS** speak to a trusted grown up!

Bullying can be:

**Physical:** Hurting someone with their hands or feet, punching, kicking, hitting.

**Verbal:** Saying unkind things, calling people names.

**Cyber:** Saying unkind things on the computer or by text or email. This could be on an iPad too. Sometimes Cyber bullying can happen outside of school. You must always speak to a trusted grown up if something is worrying you.

**Written:** Letters or notes saying unkind things.



What should I do if I see someone else being bullied?

- Tell a trusted grown up
- Help them
- Tell the bully to stop



Who can I tell?

- A grown up
- A friend or someone in your class
- Your parents
- Anyone in school
